The Fulflood Charity Ball aims to hold a large formal event for circa 400 people with a charity auction and raffle in order to raise funds for a chosen local charity.

The inaugural Fulflood Ball was held in 2012 and raised £8000 for the children's ward at Winchester Hospital. The second was held in April 2014 and raised £17,000 for The Theatre Royal Centenary. The third occasion in 2015 raised a staggering £25,000 for Home-Start Winchester and the fourth in 2016 raised £23,000 for Street Reach Winchester. Our fifth Ball supported Trinity Winchester

The Ball was the brainchild of local Fulflood photographer, Catherine Skinner, and is organised by a committee of dedicated local residents. More details of the ball can be found at www.fulfloodball.co.uk

Our ethos is to support local charities for which the kind of sums listed above will make a significant difference to the services that they can provide.

Applications will not be considered for:

- Support outside the local area or groups that supply support on a national or international basis.
- General appeals.

- Marketing or promotional activity ie leaflets, posters, etc.
- Funding for any NHS projects that should be supported by the Government.
- Dangerous activities.
